Electric Storage Heaters

What are they?

Electric Storage Heaters are stand-alone heating units which are typically used in 'living' areas.

How does they work?

Electricity supply is drawn at night, at a cheaper off-peak rate, and is stored in special heat-retaining bricks for use the following day. Controls can be used to manually set the amount of heat being released.

Benefits

They can be a cheaper, more flexible and low maintenance alternative than installing a new central heating system. They are also ideal for those who do not have access to mains gas supplies.

What are the potential savings?

According to the Energy Saving Trust, electricity bill savings from traditional fan assisted heaters can be up to:

> **£150**

What are the typical costs?

If you were to have this measure installed without Green Deal, this would typically cost you upfront:
